

AAUW of Salem SPEECH TREK CONTEST INFORMATION – 2020

Speech Trek is part of Salem Reads 2020. The Salem community selected *Piecing Me Together* by Renée Watson for the fourth season of <u>Salem Reads: One Book, One Community</u>. This compelling and thoughtful story (based in Portland, Oregon) explores issues of friendships, race, privilege, and identity.

Free copies of *Piecing Me Together* are available at the Salem Public Library, or your local community library, and at libraries in the Salem-Keizer school district.

2020 Contest Theme: Race, Equity and Opportunity

Contestants are **REQUIRED to READ**: *Piecing Me Together* by Renée Watson and then prepare a persuasive speech focusing on <u>one</u> of the following topics:

1. What can be done to change the climate of racism in our country?

For example: What can be done to address racism in your own community, neighborhood or school?

2. What can be done to improve equity for all young women in our country?

For example: What can be done to address equity in the state of Oregon?

3. What can be done to increase opportunity for all girls in our country?

For example: What can be done to increase opportunity for girls in schools and communities?

Eligibility: Speech Trek is open to high school girls in 10th and 11th grade in the Cascade, Central, Dallas, Falls City, North Santiam, Salem-Keizer, and Silver Falls Oregon school districts.

Time Limits: Students are to prepare an original 5-6 minute speech, with a 30 second grace period on either side. Speaking under the 4:30 or over 6:30 will result in disqualification.

Presentation: These presentations are to be original speeches. Appropriate use of one 4"x6" note card is an option -- prompting is not allowed.

Speech Trek is limited to **20 participants chosen on a first come first served** basis. Two rounds will be held at the same time. If you do not advance to the final round, you are free to leave. There will be a final round where the winners will be chosen.

Speeches must make at least one reference to the book, Piecing Me Together.

Judging: During both rounds of competition, judges shall use the official ballot and score each speaker in each of the four areas: Content (0-40 points), Organization (0-10 points); and Delivery (0-50 points). The official ballot is included on our website (salem-or.aauw.net).

Finalists: First place winner will receive \$500; Second place \$300 and Third place \$200.
